### **Michigan Nursing Scholarships**

Must be attending a participating school at least 1 /2 time on track to gaining one of the following:

LPN certification, AND, BSN or MSN. Recipients are selected by your school's financial aid office. How they determine recipients is up to them. Also, if you receive the award you'll be agreeing to work as a nurse at one of several healthcare facilities in Michigan that participate in the Michigan Nursing Scholarship Program. Or you could opt to teach nursing at a specified institution for however many years you received assistance. Previous scholarship recipients are not eligible to reapply under the same category. However, qualified previous recipients may apply for the next category.

ENA members having served in the immediate past three years on the ENA Board of Directors, ENA Foundation Board of Trustees, or ENA Foundation Scholarship Review Team are ineligible to apply.
